

Based on the above information, with the current rate of Sunday collections being 1% higher than last year, if that trend continues then the parish can expect to be \$32,000 short of the budgeted amount for Sunday collections.

The expenses are slightly higher than last year; however, they appear to be close to the overall budgeted amount for expenses.

With Fr. Brian, Gail, and Marian leaving at the end of July, and Rita leaving at the end of June, the parish is given the opportunity to do an overall discernment of the current needs of the parish and create new positions and job descriptions. It is hoped that the parish will do the discernment in a synodal way (through prayer and consultation with many people and groups). To do so, the Parish Pastoral Council and Parish Finance Council will need to develop a committe to guide the discernment and hiring process.

The contracts for the company doing the cleaning (on Sunday and Thursday evenings) and the company doing the snow removal and lawn care can be cancelled with one month notice, if needed.

Because a new priest will be pastoring the parish starting in August (Fr. Oliver), and new staff are needed, it is an opportunity to go in a new direction. Fr. Brian will be away for about half of June; he won't have time to provide orientation and training for new people due to other commitments and responsibilities in the diocese; and he won't be around at the end of the probationary periods for the new staff. Therefore it would be inappropriate for him to actively participate in the discernment, screening and hiring process. Instead, it is recommended that the discernment hiring committee invite Fr. Oliver to participate in the discernment and hiring process because he will be working with the new people.
